

1000 Enterprises for Children-In-Need Appreciation Dinner 2011



On 10 March 2011, Singapore Children's Society held an Appreciation Dinner at Marina Mandarin to thank the 382 corporate partners in the 1000 Enterprises for Children-In-Need (1000E) initiative in 2010. Among them were the Presenter of the initiative Noble Group and the Society's Community Partner, OCBC Bank.
